

Our mission is PATIENT-CENTRIC.


- We aim to provide affordable yet professional eye care services to everyone. No matter who you are our mission is to save your sight.








HOUSING MINISTRY CONDUCTS FREE EYE SCREENING FOR STAFF




FREE SURGICAL OUTREACH TO LAFIA, NASSARAWA STATE, NIGERIA

We distributed free medications and glasses, and performed cataract extractions for several individuals. Each smile that emerged after regaining sight mirrored our purpose: regardless of who you are, our mission is to preserve your sight.













MR. JOHN CAN SEE AGAIN A MIRACLE AT NORTHERNLIGHT

Mr John was a farmer from Nassarawa state Nigeria whose vision suddenly began to diminish. A very agile person now needs the help of his family members to move around. He struggled with everything because he can't see and as the condition grew worse he barely could recognise anyone.



The lack of funds made it impossible for him to get the right treatment for his eye disease, the income from farming wasn't sufficient enough to afford him an eye surgery.

Then one day, someone who had accessed care from our organisation told his wife about NorthernLight Eye Centre, immediately they called the office line and asked where our camp location was and our front desk told them.

He was thoroughly examined and was told his treatment will be completely free, the joy on his face was palpable knowing that for the first time in months, he would see again.

The surgery was successfully done and Mr John has returned back to his farm.

NorthernLight will continue to stand as a beacon of hope to those who have lost hope.


KEY STATISTICS INCLUDE:

- World Glaucoma Week: 110 patients (5 surgeries)


THESE CAMPS SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED EYE CARE ACCESSIBILITY AND COMMUNITY AWARENESS.

Disease categories:




Measurement categories by gender
